

## Privacy Policy

In accordance with Art. 13 par. 1 and par. 2 of the Regulation (EU) 2016/679 of the European Parliament and of the Council of 27 April 2016 on the protection of natural persons with regard to the processing of personal data and on the free movement of such data, and repealing Directive 95/46/EC (General Data Protection Regulation – hereinafter GDPR), I inform that:

1. This privacy policy defines the rules for collecting, processing and using information, including the personal data of users visiting the [dsh@waw.pl](mailto:dsh@waw.pl) website and making purchases in an online bookshop operated by Dom Spotkań z Historią (the History Meeting House).
2. The data controller of your personal data is Dom Spotkań z Historią, ul. Karowa 20, 00-324 Warsaw.

4. Your personal data will be processed in order to send information about the activities of the data controller pursuant to Art. 6 par. 1(a) of the GDPR.
5. The recipient of your personal data will be entities authorised to process data on the basis of a data entrustment agreement for the above purpose and may be transferred to entities authorised by law.
6. Your personal data will not be transferred to a third country/international organisation.
7. Your personal data will be stored until consent is revoked or in accordance with archiving regulations.
8. You have the right to access your data and the right to rectify or remove them, restrict their processing, the right to transfer data, to object, and the right to withdraw consent at any time without affecting the lawfulness of processing (if the basis for processing is lawful), which was made on the basis of consent before its withdrawal.
9. You have the right to lodge a complaint with a supervisory authority if you feel that the processing of your personal data violates the provisions of the general regulation on the protection of personal data or national regulations.
10. Providing your personal data is voluntary, but necessary for the implementation of the above mentioned purpose.
11. Your data will be neither processed automatically nor profiled.
